



Americans with Disabilities Act

Special Recreation Services of Sertoma Star Services supports the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). SRS will provide all reasonable accommodations to include persons with disabilities in the community. It is the belief of SRS that all people are created equal and that they should have equal rights to recreation and leisure opportunities in their communities.

Inclusion

SRS supports programs that allow the participants to perform in the least restrictive environment. Some participants may choose traditional SRS programs, while others may choose park district and recreation department-offered programs. In cooperation with park district/recreation department staff, SRS will provide additional support for all persons interested in inclusion services in park district/recreation department programs. Contact SRS for additional information.

Program Cancellation & Credit Policy

Program Information:

- If no participants arrive within the first 15 minutes at the scheduled program time, the program will be canceled, and staff will be sent home. No credits will be given.
- If the program is canceled, program staff will attempt to reach all participants by phone and email to inform them.
- SRS attempts to extend programs to make up missed dates. You will be notified of program extensions.
- All credits/refunds will be reviewed and disbursed after review by the Executive Director.
- Please note that a doctor's note may be required with the credit request.
- Once a program has begun, no credits will be given.

Out-of-district participants include those not part of the member districts, the corresponding school district, or affiliation with Sertoma Star Services. SRS will accept out-of-district participants into our program with the registration and payment of a \$1,200 annual maintenance fee. This fee, paid to SRS, can be made in installments or all at once. Registration Information:

- Contact Program Manager, Nancy DiGangi (<u>ndigangi@sertomastar.org</u>), or Recreation Supervisor, Shevon Reed (<u>sreed@sertomastar.org</u>), to schedule an appointment to register for programs. Payment arrangements will be made at the time of registration.
- Complete the Annual Information Form, filling in all appropriate spaces. Annual Information Forms are due at the time of registration.
- Program Registration: Checks made out to Sertoma Star Services (SRS) or cash are accepted. Please write the participant's name on the check. Full payment must be included. You will be notified if a program is canceled or if placed on a waiting list.
- Delinquent accounts: participants will be denied participation if a balance remains from a previous season, or a late pick-up fee has not been paid. For participants attending a program without prior registration and payment, a \$10 administrative fee will be added to each program that is attended. This fee must be paid in full before registration can be taken.
